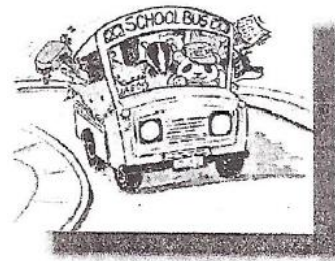

In cooperation with neighborhood churches, Skilton House Ministries is promoting Christian Released Time Education (CRT) for Philadelphia public school children. The idea of CRT is for Christians all over the city to provide instruction in the faith for children in public schools. With parental permission, this would be done during regular school hours, as allowed under section 1546 of the "Public School Code," as amended by Act 175 of 1982. Children are released for one hour per week for not more than 36 weeks of the school year. The Bible is used as the textbook. Children learn about the attributes of God and the Christian life. Much of the work involves Bible memorization. The cost to you, the parent, is free. Skilton House Ministries has been serving Philadelphia citizens since 1983.
